End of Hostilities of the Vietnam War

The Huntington Veterans Advisory Board and the Huntington Town Veterans Committee has spent the past ten years developing and building the Huntington Veterans Plaza on the front lawn of Huntington Town Hall.

We unveiled a monument in 2003 to mark the official 30th Anniversary of the secession of Hostilities of the Viet Nam War. To commemorate this Anniversary, we have erected a new Viet Nam War Monument, which is opposite to the World War II and Korean monuments and also enhance the plaza. We are now in the process of adding one additional plaque to this monument. Please visit Veterans Plaza to view all our monuments.

To have the name of a Viet Nam Era Veteran added to this new monument, please fill out the attached coupon and mail it in along with a copy of DD214. **PLEASE DO NOT SEND IN ORIGINAL DOCUMENTS**, as we cannot return any items received by mail). In addition, we are asking for a **minimum donation of \$15.00** per veteran's name in order to defray the expense of the monument. To be eligible the Viet Nam Era Veteran must have been a resident of Huntington anytime in their lifetime for a minimum of six months, and have served anywhere in the military of our Country, anytime from February 28, 1961 to May 7th,1975.
