

NOTICE OF A SPECIAL REFERENDUM ELECTION

To all Huntington Residents:

On Tuesday, Dec. 22, 2009, a special referendum election will be held to decide the following question:

“Shall a ward system be established for the election of councilmen/councilwomen in the Town of Huntington?”

The voting will take place from 6 a.m. to 9 p.m. at the usual general election polling places.

Here are some key dates you might want to know about:

Registering to Vote

If you are not registered and want to vote in this referendum, you can register by mail if your application to the Suffolk County Board of Elections is postmarked by Nov. 27, 2009.

If you are not registered and want to vote in this referendum, you can register in person at the Suffolk County Board of Elections any time before Dec. 11, 2009.

Voting by Absentee Ballot

If you want to vote by absentee ballot, you can apply by mail. The deadline for mailing that application is Dec. 15, 2009. You can also apply in person at the Board of Elections. The deadline for in-person application is Dec. 21, 2009.
